The festival includes educational sessions, meetings with fans, master classes from Gazprom Academy coaches, selection of young players for training camps in St. Petersburg, as well as a largescale city festival for Zenit supporters.

The centrepiece of the Grand Festival of Football was the football pitch, where young footballers were able to showcase their talents to the Academy's coaches. More than 2300 children in 7 cities participated in the selection process. Following a series of tests conducted by Zenit Academy coaches, six winners from each city were selected who went to a training camp in St. Petersburg at the end of July.



THE IMPACT OF THE PANDEMIC



Due to the coronavirus pandemic and related restrictions, the last Grand Festival of Football was held in 2019.

Nevertheless, several factors at once inspire considerable optimism about the event's imminent resumption:
